CASH to ACCOUNT - From 1/6/2019 all our clients will be on account. Clients will receive an invoice at the end of each month. The cost of your trips will be exactly the same - \$10.00 each way for local trips. You can pay your account by cheque, credit card or electronic funds transfer direct into our bank account - details will be on your invoice. It is very important that when you pay us through your bank that you put the invoice number on the transaction so that we know which invoice the payment applies to.

SATURDAY SOCIAL DAY TRIPS

A LONGER DAY OUT STOPPING FOR MORNING TEA AND LUNCH - COST \$45.00 PER PERSON

AUGUST 10TH - OLD GOVERNMENT HOUSE - PARRAMATTA.

Situated on the traditional lands of the Burramatta Darug, World Heritage listed Old Government House is the oldest surviving public building in Australia. Built by convicts, it became the decision-making centre of the colony and served as the 'country residence' for the first ten Governors of Australia.

Today, this elegant Georgian house stands in 200 acres of parkland, overlooking the Parramatta River. It is home to the National Trust's premier colonial furniture collection, early textiles and significant homewares from the time of the Governors. Entry is \$15.00 for a guided tour. Lunch at a club in Parramatta.



AUGUST 24TH - BUNDEENA RSL

Stay warm in the bus and we will take you for a drive down through Sydney's heritage listed National Park. We will stop in the picturesque village of Bundeena. We will stop for lunch at the Bundeena Community and Services Club.



SEPTEMBER 14TH SEPTEMBER - EBENEZER CHURCH AND LUNCH IN THE HISTORIC TOWN OF WINDSOR

Ebenezer church overlooks the Hawksbury river in a rural/bush land area this is 12km from the township on Windsor. Built in 1809, Ebenezer church is the oldest existing church in Australia. It became the first Presbyterian church in Australia in 1824 and is now a member of the Uniting Church in Australia. We will stop for a look around the church then take you into Windsor for lunch.



SEPTEMBER 28TH - BOWRAL TULIPS

Tulips are the stars of spring. Experience a kaleidoscope of tulips carpeting public gardens and premier private gardens during Tulip Time in the Southern Highlands. The 75,000 mass-planted tulips nestled among blossoming mature trees in Corbett Gardens are the centrepiece of the Tulip Time Festival where there is daily live musical entertainment, Bowral is where the idea for the Mary Poppins character originated when the author, P L Travers lived there during her teens. Celebrating 85 years since the first book was written, the magic of Mary Poppins will transform Corbett Gardens into a wonderland of colour, music and fun in 2019. This is a popular trip so book early.

Enjoy the scenic drive up to the coastal town of Terrigal. There will be time for a walk along the beach then we will have lunch at Terrigal Bowling Club
